**TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER
AND ORDER SETTING HEARING ON
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION**

The Court, having reviewed Plaintiffs' Ex Parte Application for Temporary Restraining Order and Motion for Preliminary Injunction, and all other pleadings and affidavits on file herein, and for good cause appearing, finds that this is a proper instance for a temporary restraining order to be issued and that if Defendants State of Nevada, Department of Business and Industry Financial Institutions Division (the "FID") and Commissioner George E. Burns (the "Commissioner") are not restrained and enjoined by order of this Court, Plaintiffs will suffer immediate and irreparable injury. Accordingly.

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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the FID and the Commissioner, together with any
2 and all of its or his agents, servants, employees, and attorneys are hereby restrained and
3 enjoined from enforcing in any way the Declaratory Order and Advisory Opinion Regarding
4 Collection Agency Fees From Homeowner Association Liens Following Foreclosure, which
5 was issued by the FID on November 18, 2010 (the "Declaratory Order").


6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary
7 Injunction be, and the same hereby is, set for hearing on the 7th day of Dec, 2010, at
8 8:30 o'clock, a.m., in Department XXII of the above-entitled Court. Notice of said
9 hearing and the time and place thereof shall be given to Defendants no later than
10 Dec 6, 2010, @ 12 noon, by serving upon it a copy of this Temporary Restraining Order,
11 together with a copy of the moving papers.

12 IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall post a bond or cash with
13 the Court in the amount of \$2500 in accordance with NRCP 65(c) as security for the
14 payment of such costs and damages as may be incurred or suffered by any party who is found
15 to have been wrongfully enjoined or restrained in this action.

16 IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that this Temporary Restraining Order shall
17 remain in effect until the hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction unless
18 further extended by order of this Court or stipulation of the parties.
